1	The capital city of England is London. 	6	Thomas Farriner owned the bakery on Pudding Lane where the fire started.	11	Fewer than 10 people died in the fire.
2	The fire started on 1st September 1666.	7	To stop the fire from spreading, people pulled down their houses.	12	The fire ended on 5th September 1666.
3	The King of London at the time of the fire was King Charles II. 	8	People carried their possessions to safety using boats on the River Thames.	13	Christopher Wren designed and rebuilt parts of London. 
4	The population of London at the time of the fire was 500,000.	9	St Pauls cathedral was destroyed in the fire.	14	The fire ended the plague in London at that time. 
5	Samuel Pepys kept a diary during the fire. 	10	Fire engines were used after The Great Fire of London. 	15	After the fire, houses were then built of bricks.
