2- King Athelstan: 925-939

The first king of England and Alfred the Great's grandson.

3- Alfred the Great: 849-899

Most famous for defending his kingdom against the Vikings.

4- King Offa: 757–796

One of the most powerful kings. The ruler of Mercia.

5- King Ethelbert: 589–616.

The first English King to convert to Christianity.

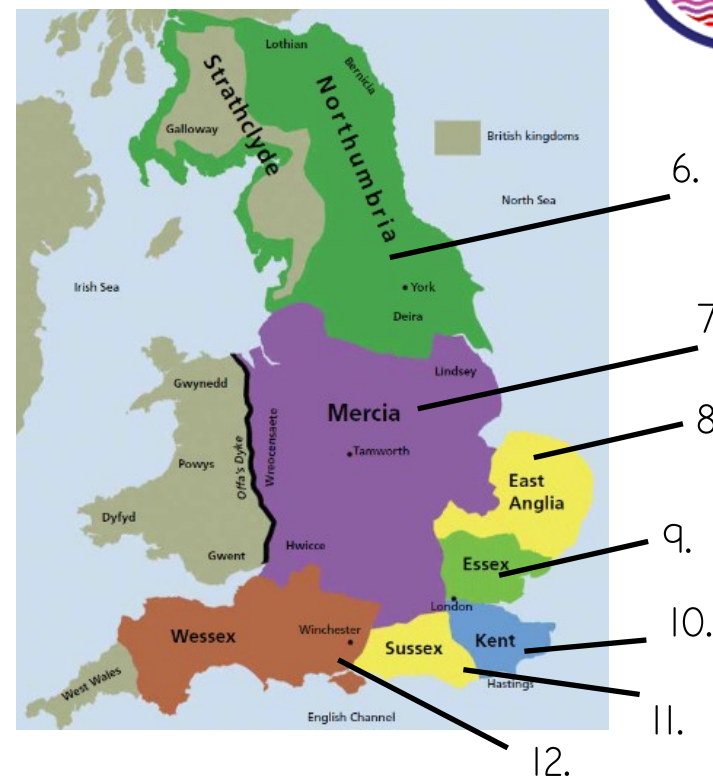
