4) Anne of Cleves (m. 1540 - 1540) divorced



5) Catherine Howard (m. 1540 - 1542) beheaded



6) Catherine Parr (m. 1543 - 1547) remained married until Henry VIII



Religion

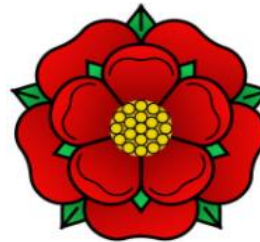
7) Catholicism - Majority of the nation were Catholic.

18) 1553
Mary I becomes Queen

19) 1558
Elizabeth accedes the throne.

20) 1603
Queen Elizabeth I dies.
